- · Selection criteria includes academic performance, work experience, faculty and employer recommendations, and career goals
- · All candidates will be subject to a background/suitability investigation
- To officially accept the scholarship, selected applicants must sign a mobility agreement as well as an agreement to complete a service obligation of at least two years at a VA health care facility after graduating and obtaining necessary licensure/certification
