4004.4 A PA who is retired from full or part-time practice and otherwise qualified to be a fellow or associate NCAPA member may apply for retired status under the Sustaining Member category. These applications will be reviewed for approval by the Membership Committee.

Retired status will afford the individual all of the rights and privileges of the membership status at the time of application, except the right to vote and hold office. Once the application is approved, the dues for the retiree will be reduced to 50% of the regular fee for membership. This will affect only the NCAPA membership, not any bundled memberships.
